1) Organising Authority:

The Organising Authority is
Roadford Lake Sailing Club in conjunction with the RS Association.

2) Rules:

2.1 The regatta will be governed by The Racing Rules Sailing 2009-2012, the prescriptions of the RYA, the rules of the RS Association.

3) Eligibility and Entry:

The regatta is open to members of the RS Association. Non-members may pay an additional event fee as allowed by the RS Association Rules.
Eligible boats may pre enter by completing the entry form available from the RLSC and send to Richard Willows, address below. This will greatly assist us in pre organising the event and matching resources to entry numbers.

Entrants and authorised guests are temporary members of Roadford Lake Sailing Club during the period of the event and shall comply with Club Rules and Bylaws.

4) Entry fee:

The entry fee will be £25.00. Entries can be made by post or email before the event (preferred, pre-entry £20.00), or at registration at the times stated below. Cheques payable to Roadford Lake Sailing Club.

5) Advertising:

In accordance with ISAF regulation 20.3 (d) (i), boats shall display on each side of the bow while racing any advertising supplied by the event organiser at registration.

6) Registration:

This will take place in the Race Office from 1200 hrs on Saturday 25th June.

7) Briefing:

This will take place at 13:15 hrs in the area of the Race hut on Saturday 25th June

8) Schedule of Races:

Saturday 3 races	Time of First Warning Signal	
Races 1, 2, 3	13:55 hrs	

Sunday	Time of First Warning Signal	
Races 4, 5, 6	09:55 hrs	All back to back

The Warning signal will be the Vario Class Flag. The Race Committee may bring forward a race or races but there will be no more than 4 races per day. Any change to the schedule of races will be made before the first warning signal of the day & only after discussion with competitors. There will be no warning signal after 15:00 hrs on the last day except for a general recall.

9) Sailing area and courses:

The sailing area will be on Roadford Lake. Courses sailed will be windward/leeward courses. Time to start area 5 minutes

10) Sailing Instructions:

These will be available from the Race Office on completion of registration or from the RLSC and the RS websites.

12) Scoring:

Three completed races are required to constitute a series. One discard will apply if between 4 and 6 races are completed.

13) Safety and Disclaimer of Liability:

13.1 A competitor is responsible for their own safety, whether afloat or ashore and nothing, whether in the Notice of Race or Sailing instructions or anywhere else reduces this responsibility.

13.2 It is for the competitor to decide whether they are fit to sail in the conditions. By going afloat the competitor confirms they are fit and competent to sail and compete in those conditions.

13.3 Nothing done by the organisers can reduce the liability of the competitor nor will it make the organisers responsible for any loss, damage, death or personal injury, however it may occur, as a result of the boat taking part in the series. The organisers encompass everyone helping to run the race and include the organising authority, the race committee, the race officer, patrol boats and beach masters.

13.4 The provision of patrol boats does not relieve the competitor of his/her responsibilities.

13.5 Each boat is required to hold adequate insurance and in particular against third party claims of at least £2,000,000.

14) Boat Parking:

Boats should be left in the boat park, or as directed by a member of the event organising team.

15) Car Parking:

Cars should be parked in the car park as directed. No cars in the boat park please.

16) Prize-giving:

This will be in the area of the Watersports Centre as soon as possible after completion of racing on Sunday.

17) Changes to Sailing Instructions:

All changes will be posted at least one hour before the start of the race(s) affected.

These will be displayed at the race hut, where Flag L will be flown.,

A. Other Information:
